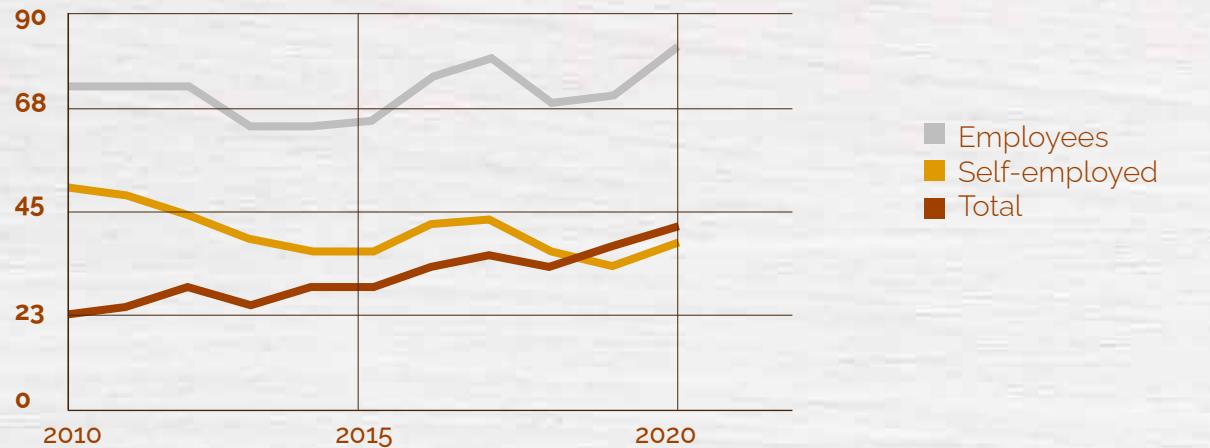

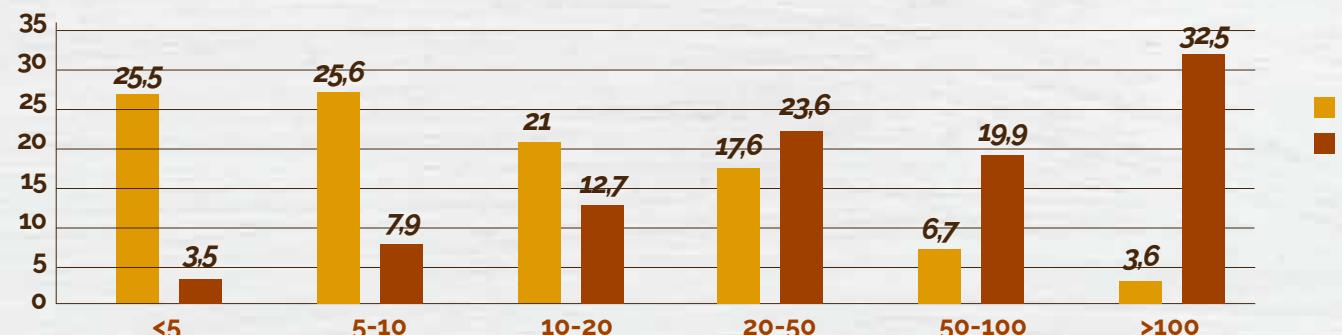
## Work and employment in Emilia-Romagna 2010-2020

## Distribution of agricultural holdings (%) and areas by size classes (Ha) in 2020

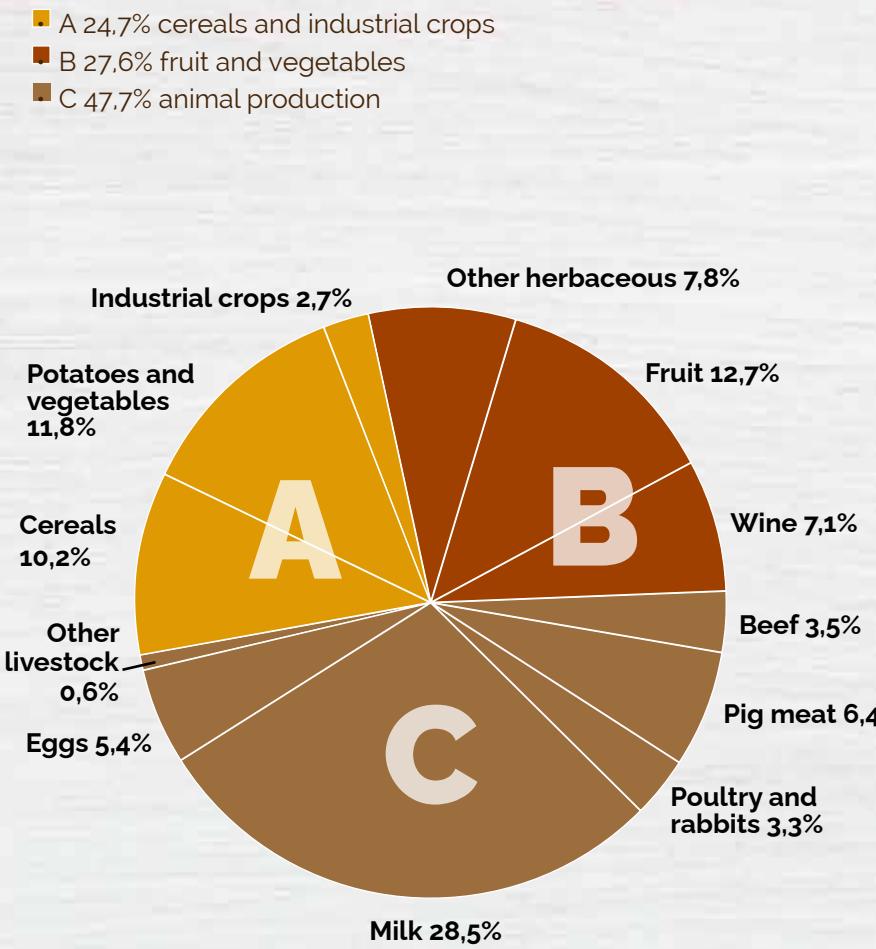

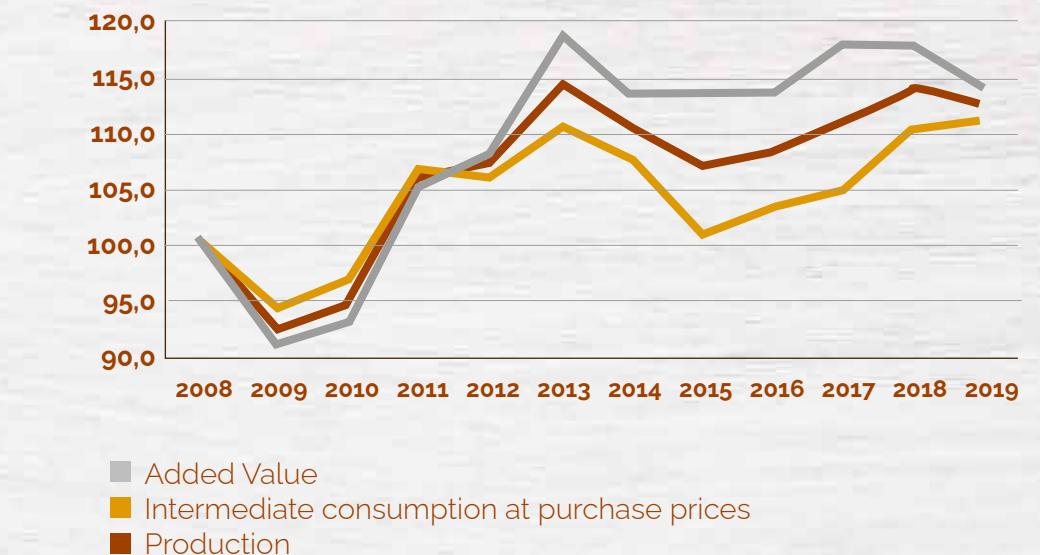

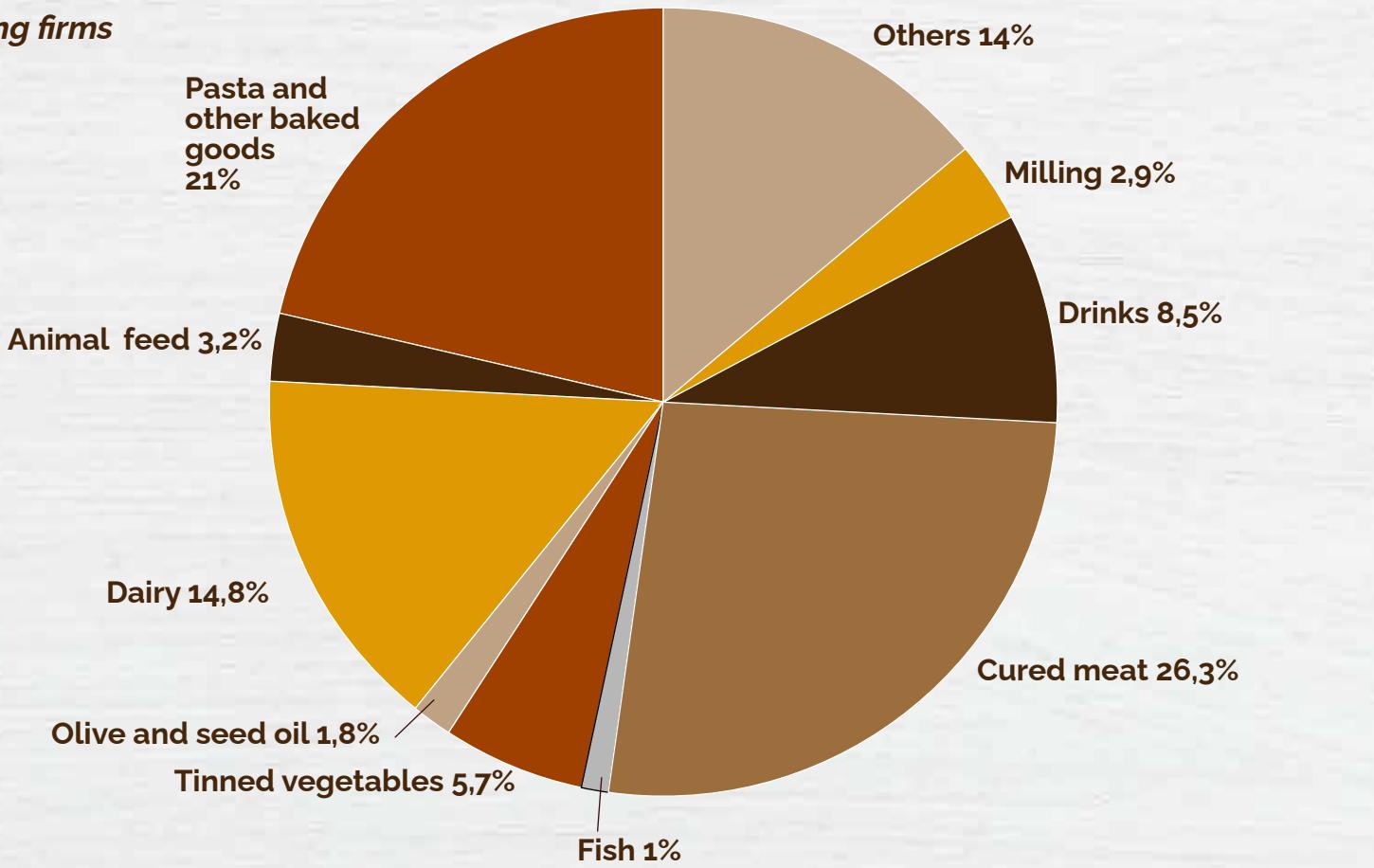

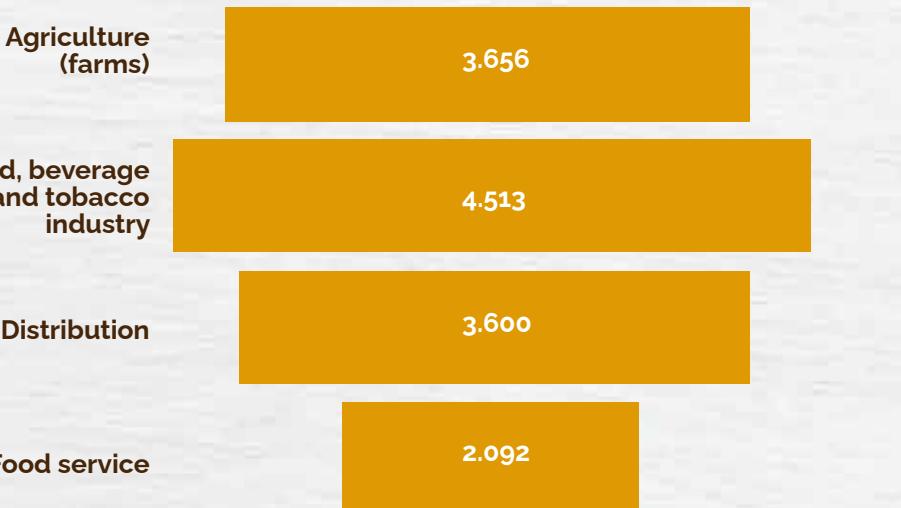

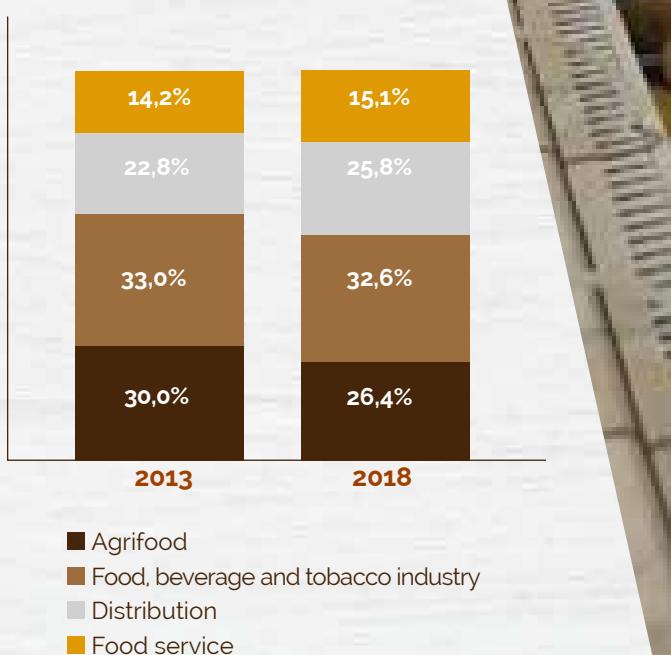
*Emilia-Romagna: value added produced by the components of the AA supply chain 2018 (million €)*

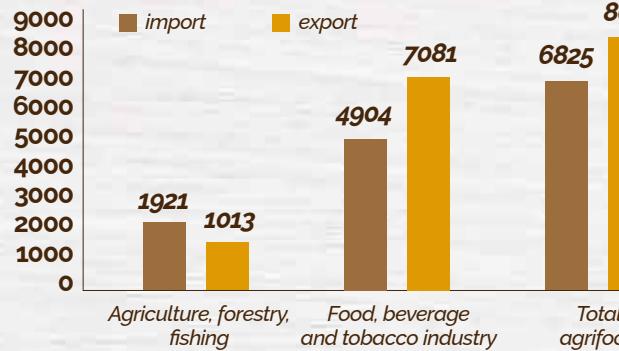

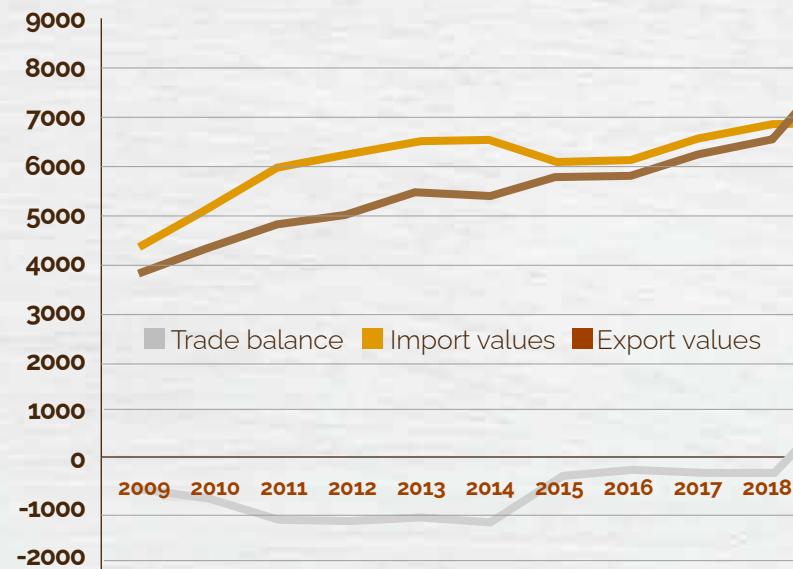
Foreign trade of agrofood products 2019 (million €)

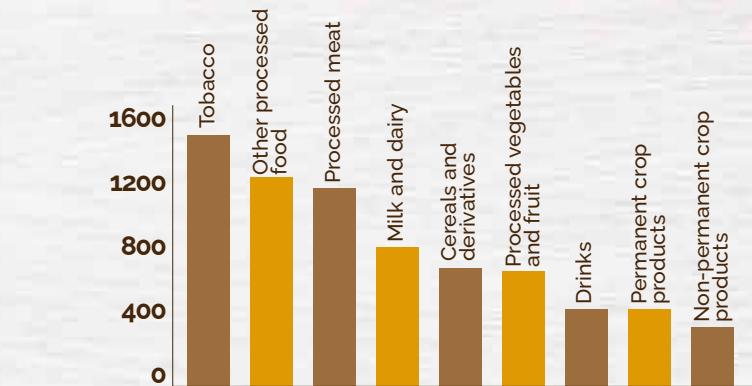
Foreign trade in Emilia-Romagna

Agrifood trade years: Import, Export, Balance 2009-2019 (million €)

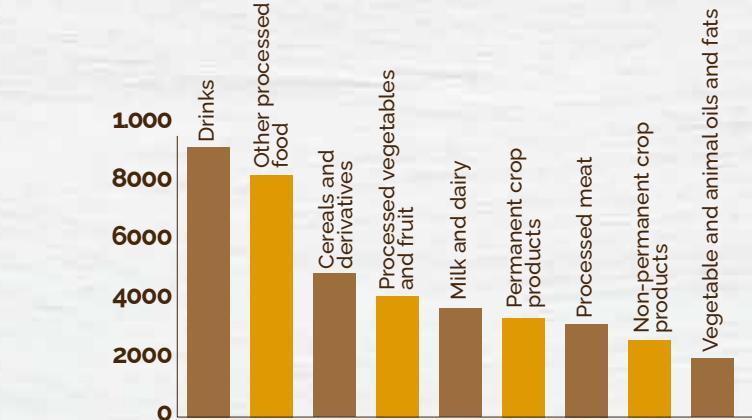

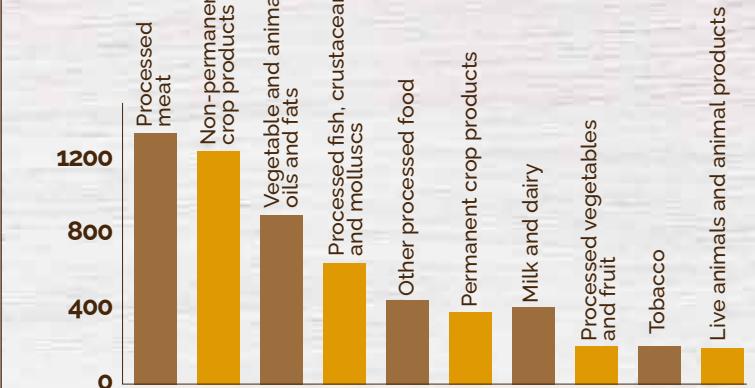

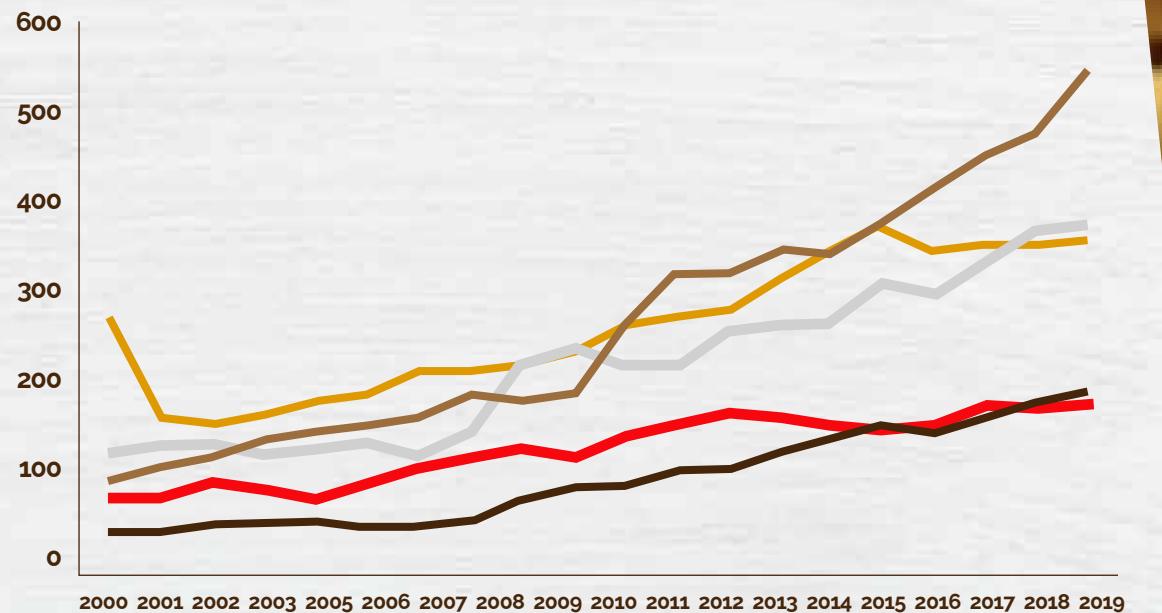

# Emilia-Romagna a leading agricultural region in Italy and Europe

## PDO and PGI products

- Emilia-Romagna is the most representative region in Italy for quality agrifood products, both in terms of geographical indications (44 PDO and 312 PGI) and economic value.
- Emilia-Romagna has more than 40% of the turnover of Italian PDOs (Grana Padano is mainly in other regions); the total turnover for the best four PDO-PGI products (4.265 million €) is 55.4%.

## Farming production system for better water and soil management in the food chain, containing rules:

- for pest and weed control to reduce the use of pesticides;
- to reduce and optimize the use of fertilizers, according to the type of soil;
- manure treatment and disposal;
- for crop rotation, soil management irrigation technical advisory service including forecasting models based on weather conditions.

## Impact of sustainable farming in Emilia-Romagna (2014-2022)

Outcomes of mid-term evaluations - September 2021

Water quality
Nitrogen fertilizers supply decreased (31.4% in organic farming).
Most toxic pesticides decreased (32.4% in organic + integrated farming)
(Source: Assessment based on sample survey)
Soil erosion
Soil conservation practices that reduce soil erosion applied on 107.402 ha (about 35% of the hilly and mountainous UAA)
Soil organic matter (SOM)
In areas under agri-environmental commitments, only a slight increase in SOM is expected (on average 0.113 t/ha·y)
Climate change mitigation
Agro-climatic-environmental measures achieved results: Greenhouse gas emissions from agriculture and livestock decreased by 18,730 t CO <sub>2</sub> eq/y Increase of carbon stored in soils and vegetation by 79.785 t CO <sub>2</sub> eq/y

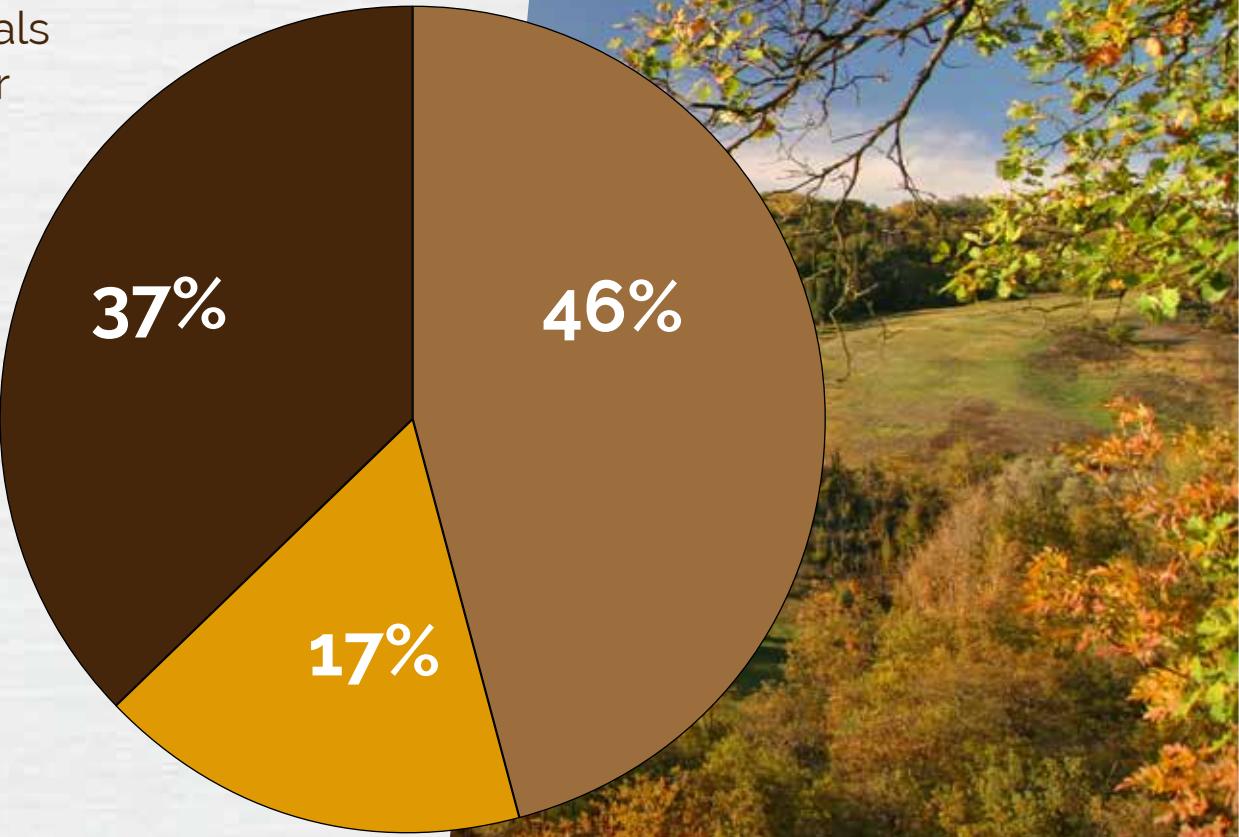
